Prior to that she served as the Legislative Director to the Senate Appropriations Chair, former Senator, now Insurance Commissioner Ricardo Lara, staffing dozens of pieces of legislation, including what ultimately became Proposition 58 and repealed restrictions on multilingual education. Megan is a graduate of UC Santa Cruz and has two children.

Megan works on budget, special education, alternatives to discipline, and homeless and foster youth issues for ACSA among others.
