Iván Carrillo is a longtime advocate for public schools with deep expertise in shaping education policy. He began his legislative career in 2009 through the prestigious Assembly Fellows Program. Over the next seven years serving in the California State Legislature, Iván championed policies, secured critical funding, and developed programs to support students and educators across California.

In 2016, Iván joined the Association of California School Administrators (ACSA) as a Legislative Advocate. In this role, he led advocacy efforts on key issues including the state budget, school finance, mental health, school discipline, pensions, as well as alternative and adult education. Since 2022, Iván has served as ACSA's Senior Director of Policy and Governmental Relations, where he leads the organization's state and federal advocacy work.

Iván is an alumnus of the University of California, Davis, where he made history as the first community college transfer student—and second Latino—to be elected student body president. He has exhibited a longstanding commitment to youth empowerment, exemplified by his service with the Chicano Latino Youth Leadership Project (CLYLP), where he previously held the role of Board President.
